

PARADE RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All floats and drivers must be ready to begin parade one(1) hour before the parade. Please make sure the driver is in the cab of his truck or car at this time.
2. All security guards must be approved by Mardi Gras of SWLA and Ronnie Dartez of the CPSO.
3. All floats are to be decorated in the theme of your choice
4. All participants must be costumed and MASKED and provide their own throws.
5. Do not throw anything during the lineup, wait until the float crosses the starting line.
6. The only things to be thrown from the floats are: beads, cups,doubloons, candy, and small toys. NO water, NO trash, NO glass, NO silly string
7. All throws must be thrown to the back of the crowd for safety precautions
8. No glass containers, guns, water guns, fireworks, silly string, underwear, or signs (“SHOW ME” various parts of the body) will be allowed.
9. No showing of various body parts from the floats, please.
10. Once the parade has started it is NOT TO STOP. The parade can only stop in cases of extreme emergency.
11. Once the parade has started, float riders must remain on the float, no getting on and off.
12. Each float must have a fire extinguisher and a ladder
13. The drivers are not allowed to throw anything or drink alcohol, during the parade
14. All floats must stay away from the area of Ryan Street and stay off of Ryan Street until it is time to parade.
15. Once the parade has crossed the FINISH LINE (Ryan&Sale Streets) all throwing MUST STOP. Anything thrown from a float, once the float crossed the finish line, will be considered LITTERING, you or your Krewe may be fined for littering according to the laws of this State of Louisiana

Failure of any parade participant to follow these rules and regulations will result in that organization being fined \$300.00 per incident, and not being asked to participate in any of the Mardi Gras of Southwest Louisiana activities again.
